Day 1: Sat, Jan 12 – Depart Honolulu, Hawaii. Air New Zealand Flight #9 at 9:45 pm.

Day 2: Sun, Jan 13 – In Transit

Day 3: Mon, Jan 14 – Arrive Sydney, Australia via Auckland at 8:30 am. Upon arrival we begin our adventure with an included City Sightseeing Tour: Botanical Gardens, Conservatorium of Music, Opera House, Darling Harbour and Chinatown. Check-in Grace Hotel - Your home for the next 2 nights.

Day 4: Tue, Jan 15 – Sydney, Australia (B). Full Day Tour to Blue Mountains & Featherdale Wildlife Park with breakfast. Evening Free in Sydney.

Day 5: Wed, Jan 16 – Sydney, Australia (B). Breakfast at hotel. Morning at your leisure. Transfer to cruise port. Embark Celebrity Solstice®. Overnight aboard ship.

Day 6: Thur, Jan 17 – Half Day Tour of Sydney Harbour via Captain Cook Cruise. Free time in city center: make own way back to cruise terminal. Ship departs at 6:30 pm.

Day 12: Wed, Jan 23 – Dunedin, New Zealand – 9:00 am - 7:00 pm. The splendor of many of its grand city buildings reflects Dunedin's economic and cultural preeminence in Victorian New Zealand, and today it has a justly deserved reputation as one of the best-preserved Victorian and Edwardian cities in the Southern Hemisphere.

Day 13: Thur, Jan 24 – Christchurch, New Zealand – 8:00 am - 6:00 pm. New Zealand's place in English history is visibly apparent in Christchurch's architecture and design. Life here revolves around enjoying its natural beauty, minimal rain and plenty of long, sunny days. Enjoy an influx of cafes and art galleries, along with world-class wineries nearby.

Day 14: Fri, Jan 25 – Wellington, New Zealand – 8:00 am - 6:00 pm. There is an immediacy and a vibrancy here that you don't get in other New Zealand cities. Once seen as a stuffy, bureaucrat-filled political capital, Wellington has reinvented itself to become New Zealand's entertainment and cultural capital.

Day 20: Thur, Jan 31 – Napier to Auckland (B). Visit: Pernel Fruit Orchard/Fruit World for wagon tour and fruit tastings, Huka Falls, and Taupo. Evening free in Auckland. Overnight: Heritage Hotel Auckland.

Day 21: Fri, Feb 1 – Auckland (B, L). Full-day tour of Auckland via private coach. Visit: North Shore of Auckland, Mount Eden, Parnell Village, War Memorial Museum Maori Court, Mission Bay, Antarctic Encounter and Underwater World. Lunch at Harbourside Seafood Bar & Grill on Waitemata Harbour. Overnight: Heritage Hotel Auckland.
