Day 1: Fri, October 5 • Tue, November 6 • Thur, March 28 — Depart Honolulu

Day 2: Sat, October 6 • Wed, November 7 • Fri, March 29 — Arrive Beijing, China in the evening. Overnight Hotel Stay (5-Star, city centre).

Day 3: Sun, October 7 • Thur, November 8 • Sat, March 30 — Beijing, China (AB, L, SD). After breakfast, visit the Summer Palace, which is said to be the best preserved imperial garden in the world. Next visit a fresh water Pearl shop. After lunch walk around Tiananmen Square, known as the largest and most magnificent public square in the world. Then we explore the Forbidden City, the largest and most well-preserved imperial palace whose vast and exotic grandeur was brilliantly captured in the movie, The Last Emperor. This evening's dinner features China's famous Peking Duck.

Day 4: Mon, October 8 • Fri, November 9 • Sun, March 31 — Beijing, China (AB, L, D). Begin today's full day tour with a visit to a Jade Factory. Visit the Great Wall of Juyong Pass, a UNESCO World Heritage site and a massive defensive structure built to fend off intruders. After lunch, drive through the peaceful valley where Ming emperors had chosen as their burial ground, and descend for a walk along the Sacred Way, where the Avenue of Animals can be seen lined with massive stones.

Day 5: Tue, October 9 • Sat, November 10 • Mon April 1 — Beijing - Tianjin, China (AB, L). After breakfast, visit the Temple of Heaven: widely regarded as the noblest example of religious architecture in all of China. After lunch transfer to pier and embark Diamond Princess®. Enjoy the Sail Away Party!
